

**Paramedic Medicine (Regular Track)
Certificate of Achievement (51 Credits)
For Students Seeking Admission to the Fall 2018 Program**

The Limited Entry Office will be responsible for managing the application process and the selection of students will be performed by an admissions committee.

Qualified applicants must:

- Attend a Health Programs Orientation and meet with a Health Programs Advisor prior to applying.
- Have either current National Certification as an AEMT/EMT or certification as an AEMT/EMT through the Southern Nevada Health District.
- Have all Prerequisite coursework completed.

Applicants will be ranked and selected using a point system through which points will be awarded. Please see attached Selection Criteria sheet.

PROGRAM PREREQUISITE COURSES: These are courses that must be completed before a student is considered eligible for entry into the Program. FOR SELECTION PURPOSES, PREREQUISITE COURSES FOR LIMITED ENTRY PROGRAMS MAY BE ATTEMPTED THREE TIMES. ALL ATTEMPTS INCLUDE WITHDRAWALS, AUDITS AND GRADES. THE HIGHEST GRADE WILL BE USED FOR THE GPA CALCULATION.
