



Employers, Job Seekers to Connect at CSN Career Fair

The public is invited to show off job skills to dozens of recruiters at the September 19 event

Sept. 12, 2018 – The College of Southern Nevada will host its Fall 2018 Career Fair this month, connecting students and other job seekers with local employers. The public event is scheduled for 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. September 19 in the June Whitley Student Lounge on CSN’s North Las Vegas campus.

The open forum gives job applicants the opportunity to meet recruiters from local businesses both large and small, learn about job openings and in some cases apply on the spot. Applicants should be prepared for immediate interviews, including having resumes on hand and dressing in interview attire.

“Our career fairs offer students a great opportunity to connect with many different employers in one forum,” said Bradford Glover, director of Career Services & Reentry at CSN. “Many job seekers use it as a way to learn more about potential employers. Recruiters will also be there to talk with potential applicants about their organizations and the jobs available.”
