Fall 2021 RN to BSN Bridge Program Selection Criteria

Applicants will be selected through the following point system:

➤ **CHEM 108 & PSY 240 CUMULATIVE GPA:**

- 2.50 – 2.75 = 1 point
- 2.76 – 3.00 = 2 points
- 3.01 – 3.25 = 3 points
- 3.26 – 3.50 = 4 points
- 3.51 – 3.75 = 5 points
- 3.76 – 4.00 = 6 points

➤ **HEALTH CARE EXPERIENCE:**

- Credentialed Health Occupation (not including LPN or RN)- examples can include, but are not limited to; phlebotomy, EMT, corpsmen, lab tech, x-ray tech, pharmacy tech, etc. (1 point)
-A copy of the current credential must be supplied.
- Patient care related work experience- at least six months within the last two years and clerical work will not meet the requirement. (1 point)
-CSN form completed by employer indicating work responsibilities and length of employment must be supplied. The Health Care Experience Documentation Form is available online at: <https://at.csn.edu/Nursing-AAS>. Note: Cannot be combined with health care work experience as an RN.
- Health care work experience as an RN- at least six months within the last two years and clerical is accepted. (3 points)
-CSN form completed by employer indicating work responsibilities and length of employment must be supplied. The Health Care Experience Documentation Form is available online at: <https://at.csn.edu/Nursing-AAS>. Note: Cannot be combined with patient care related work experience.

➤ **REAPPLYING STUDENTS** (Students who are reapplying following a **withdrawal or dismissal** for academic reasons or extenuating circumstance):

- 1st reapplication = 5% total point deduction
- 2nd reapplication = 10% total point deduction

***Note:** Point Deduction **does not apply** to first time applicants or applicants who were not accepted and are now reapplying.

- The completion deadline date for application materials is used as the reference point for time frames.
