CSN Student Union Construction Begins Soon

Students on the college's three campuses will get new food courts, gathering space and advising offices

LAS VEGAS, April 30, 2018 – CSN students, faculty, staff and members of the public are invited to the official Construction Kickoff event this week for the college's three new student unions.

Join CSN Acting President Margo Martin, Henderson City Councilwoman Gerri Schroder and other officials from 10-11:30 a.m. Thursday, May 3 for the kickoff celebration. The event will be behind Building C on the Henderson Campus. There will be refreshments and music, along with information about the new unions.

Architects and construction company representatives will bring interactive building models, so people can “see” what the buildings will be like. Plans call for identical 25,000-square-foot buildings on each of CSN's three campuses. Each union will have a food court, large and small meeting rooms, study space, courtyards, student government offices, advising offices, a multicultural center and sitting areas.

The Board of Regents previously approved plans for the \$80 million construction project, which will be paid for through student fees overwhelmingly supported by students. Construction will begin this summer, with grand openings set for the fall 2019 semester.
