

**Central Sterile Technician
Certificate of Completion (9 Credits)
Fall & Spring Semesters**

The Surgical Technology department will be responsible for managing the registration process. The admission list is based on a first come/first served basis.

Qualified applicants must:

- Take English placements and place into ENG 100 or ENG 101
- Possess a High School Diploma, High School Transcript or GED equivalent
- Be 18 years or older
- Meet with the Clinical Coordinator Denise Gustafson. Please email the Administrative Assistant Brooklyn Betterley at Brooklyn.Betterley@csn.edu to schedule an appointment.

The Central Sterile Technician program is **NOT** a Limited Entry program. A “Limited Entry Application for Admission to a Health Sciences program” is **NOT** necessary to begin coursework.

PROGRAM PREREQUISITE COURSES: NONE

ATTENTION: This program does require 400 hours of training at a specified clinical site, which is mandatory. In addition, students must successfully complete **SRGT 110B, SRGT 111B, and SRGT 112B**. Students are required to purchase the textbook and participate in online coursework through Canvas.
