5. Differential Fee Application ADN Program (10 minutes) **For Possible Action**

- a. The ADN (RN) program is seeking to add a differential fee stating in the fall of 2018. Every other nursing program within NSHE has a differential fee (of at least \$60/credit) to help support nursing education for students. CSN does not and once approved the differential fee would be used to:
 1. Replace existing course fees.
 2. Acquire high-fidelity simulation equipment, software, and simulation scenarios.
 3. Continue maintenance agreements and repair for high- and medium-fidelity equipment at three lab locations.
 4. Provide consumable supplies for clinical experiences and labs.
 5. Provide clinical, simulation, and lab support at multiple campus locations.
 6. Hire a full-time simulation concierge/faculty member.
 7. Faculty development for best practice instruction.
 8. Student support by providing resources to enhance theory, lab, and clinical education
 9. Offset the majority of the part-time faculty expense
- b. The Senate shall deliberate and vote upon supporting the ADN (RN) program in seeking to add a differential fee to start in the fall of 2018. A representative from the ADN (RN) Program will lead this item.
