Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) - Cash Assistance	Provides temporary cash assistance for needy families to care for dependent children in their own homes or in the homes of relative caregivers. Helps with child care and transportation				
Medicaid - Medical Assistance	Federal program administered by the state helping meet the cost of medical services for individuals receiving public assistance payments, and low income individuals and families.				
Child Care Assistance	Assists low-income families, families receiving temporary public assistance and those transitioning from public assistance in obtaining child care so they can work. Resource and referral services are available to all Nevada families at no cost.				
Energy Assistance (EAP)	Provides a supplement to assist qualifying low-income Nevadans with the cost of home energy. Eligible households receive an annual, one-time per year benefit customarily paid directly to their energy provider(s).				
Child Support Enforcement Program	Nevada's CSEP provides five basic services to both TANF and non-TANF families. They are 1) parent location; 2) establishing paternity for children
