

## *Emergency Medical Technician Certificate of Completion*

### What courses are required?

#### ***EMT***

### When are these courses offered?

The EMT courses may be offered during the spring, summer, and/or fall semester and generally are located at the West Charleston Campus and Green Valley Tech. Center. Refer to your current semester schedule to verify when and where these courses are held.

### Can I enroll in both courses at the same time?

No, the College of Southern Nevada offers a step ladder approach to classes in Emergency Medical Training. The EMT classes have open enrollment to any CSN student 18 years of age or older and provides instruction in basic emergency medical care skills. AEMT courses offer advanced training with some advanced emergency medical care skills. In order to be admitted into the AEMT (EMS 115B) training course, an individual must have completed the EMT (EMS 108B) training sequence, and must be currently certified by either a state agency or the National Registry of EMT's. **Please Note: All EMS students must attend a mandatory EMS orientation prior to attending class. ### Do I have to take an exam after completion of the courses?

Yes, after completing each sequence of courses you will take a certification exam by the National Registry of EMT's. **A certification fee of up to approximately \$115.00 may be imposed.** AEMT students must also attend a NREMT practical skills examination offered by an outside agency. Testing fees may be imposed by the agency.

### What if I am certified as an EMT in another state?

Contact the Southern Nevada Health District EMS Office (702-759-1050) to verify reciprocity. If you choose to enroll in the Advanced training course at CSN, you must show proof of either current National Certification as an EMT or current state EMT certification to the instructor on the first day of instruction.
