



ENGELSTAD SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Spring 2018 Award Cycle

The Ralph & Betty Engelstad School of Health Sciences Limited Entry Scholarship is awarded on a semester-to-semester basis to students who demonstrate financial need, excellence in academics, community service, and an ability to overcome traditional barriers to learning.

Recipients of the Engelstad Scholarship are expected to engage in community service and to act as ambassadors for the Engelstad School of Health Sciences (ESHS). This includes (but is not limited to) speaking about the school, acting as tour guides for visiting groups and being the public faces of the students of the ESHS at various functions.

The scholarship is open to any current or prospective student of an ESHS limited entry program. Students are encouraged to apply early in the process even if they are not currently accepted into a program; however, the student must be accepted into the program by the time the scholarship funds are disbursed.

There is a three step process to apply for the scholarship:

1. Fill out the attached application.
2. Bring the completed application, along with any required documentation to one of the proctored writing sessions listed below.
3. Based upon your application and writing sample scores, you may be asked to attend an interview session with members of the scholarship committee.

Thursday, November 16, 2017 room C 114 from 1:00 p.m. until 4:30 p.m.
Saturday, November 18, 2017 room I 105 from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

The writing session is limited to one hour.

For those who complete the entire application process, a combination of the application score* and interview score* will be considered to determine the final recipients of the scholarship, which is awarded as follows:

Students in a full-time Program: \$1000
Students in a part-time program: \$500
