## Guide to Setting up T-Mobile T9 HotSpot

---

Your T-Mobile T9 HotSpot will help you get devices connected to the internet. Before you can connect, you will need to set up your device by changing the admin password, the device APN, and changing the password settings.

### Configure the device APN

1. Log into the admin console after connecting to the device: <http://mobile.hotspot>
2. Click Disconnect on the main admin page.
3. Go to Settings Tab, then go to Network Settings. Select the correct APN ([b2b.t-mobile.com](http://b2b.t-mobile.com))
4. Click set as default, then you need to go back to the main page and reconnect the device.

### Change the device APN

Each device has its own SSID and default password (under the back cover of the device). You can choose to leave these alone for the time being OR change them to a new one.

If you want to change the Mobile Hotspot Network Name (SSID), follow these steps:

1. Enter <http://mobile.hotspot> or <http://192.168.0.1> in the browser of the connected device to access the Admin page.
2. Click Settings in the navigation area.
3. Select the Wi-Fi Settings tab.
4. Change the name that appears in the Network Name (SSID) field in the Wi-Fi Settings area.
5. Select or deselect the Broadcast Network Name (SSID) check box to enable or disable broadcasting the hotspot's Network Name (SSID).
6. Click Apply in the SSID area. This will save your changes on the Wi-Fi Settings tab of the Settings screen.

### Change the HotSpot Password

It is not required to change the password, but it may make it easier to remember and access the device. If you want to change the password, follow these steps:

1. Enter <http://mobile.hotspot> or <http://192.168.0.1> in the browser of the connected device to access the Admin page.
2. Click Settings in the navigation area.
3. Select the Wi-Fi Settings tab.
4. Change the value that appears in the Password field in the SSID area.
5. Click Apply in the SSID area. This will save your changes on the Wi-Fi Settings tab of the Settings screen.
