Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee online at <a href="http://www.fmjfee.com">www.fmjfee.com</a> Print the receipt and take it with you to your visa interview. You will also need to take your new I-20, Letter of Acceptance and official transcripts to the interview. Obtain official transcripts from CSN at <a href="http://www.csn.edu/transcript-information">www.csn.edu/transcript-information</a> .</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>You are leaving/have left the U.S. and coming back with a new Initial I-20 to reinstate your status upon entry into the U.S.</b> <i>You must return within 5 months of falling out of status. You must speak to an advisor in our office regarding this issue.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee online at <a href="http://www.fmjfee.com">www.fmjfee.com</a> . Print the receipt and bring it with you when traveling.</li><li>➤ If you have an expired F1 visa: you will have to apply for a new student visa. Take the SEVIS Fee receipt with you to your visa interview. You will also need to take your new I-20, Letter of Acceptance and official transcripts to the interview. Obtain official transcripts from CSN at <a href="http://www.csn.edu/transcript-information">www.csn.edu/transcript-information</a> .</li></ul> <i>Note: All students who are reinstating their status upon entry into the U.S. will not be eligible for CPT or OPT for a minimum of one year.</i>
