You must speak to an advisor in our office regarding this issue.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee online at www.fmjfee.com . Print the receipt and bring it with you when traveling.➤ If you have an expired F1 visa: you will have to apply for a new student visa. Take the SEVIS Fee receipt with you to your visa interview. You will also need to take your new I-20, Letter of Acceptance and official transcripts to the interview. Obtain official transcripts from CSN at www.csn.edu/transcript-information . <i>Note: All students who are reinstating their status upon entry into the U.S. will not be eligible for CPT or OPT for a minimum of one year.</i>
